Avalon Legal collects the following data:

How do we collect your data?

How will we use your data?

When Avalon Legal processes your order, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

Avalon Legal securely stores your data at our premises.

Avalon Legal will keep your personal data for a period of six years. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by confidential destruction.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop Avalon Legal from contacting you for marketing purposes.

What are your data protection rights?



Avalon Legal would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Avalon Legal for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Avalon Legal correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Avalon Legal to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Avalon Legal erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Avalon Legal restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Avalon Legal's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Avalon Legal transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
